## Palabra del día



### obsidiana

Se trata de un vidrio volcánico semitranslúcido, de tonalidad oscura, que se produce cuando el magma volcánico sale a la superficie terrestre en forma de lava. Se enfría tan rápidamente que sus iones no tienen tiempo de cristalizar. Los antiguos apreciaban esta sustancia por su dureza y la utilizaban para la construcción de sus armas y herramientas.

Esta piedra fue descubierta en Etiopía por un romano llamado Obsius, en cuyo homenaje Plinio la denominó *obsianus lapis*. Fue leído erróneamente como *obsidianus lapis*, y así se alteró el nombre de este material.

Según creencias que han prevalecido desde la Antigüedad, para algunos hasta hoy, entre las "propiedades" de la obsidiana estaría una función protectora y potenciadora de los atributos de la persona que la posee.

### Píldoras gramaticales

**P.:** Qué es lo correcto, los Julio César o los juliocésares?

**R.:** Según indica la *Nueva Gramática de la Lengua Española*, no hay normas seguras para la formación del plural de los nombres propios compuestos que designan personas. Lo más frecuente es que se pluralice solo el segundo componente, sobre todo si se trata de formaciones muy consolidadas: *los Julio Césares*.
